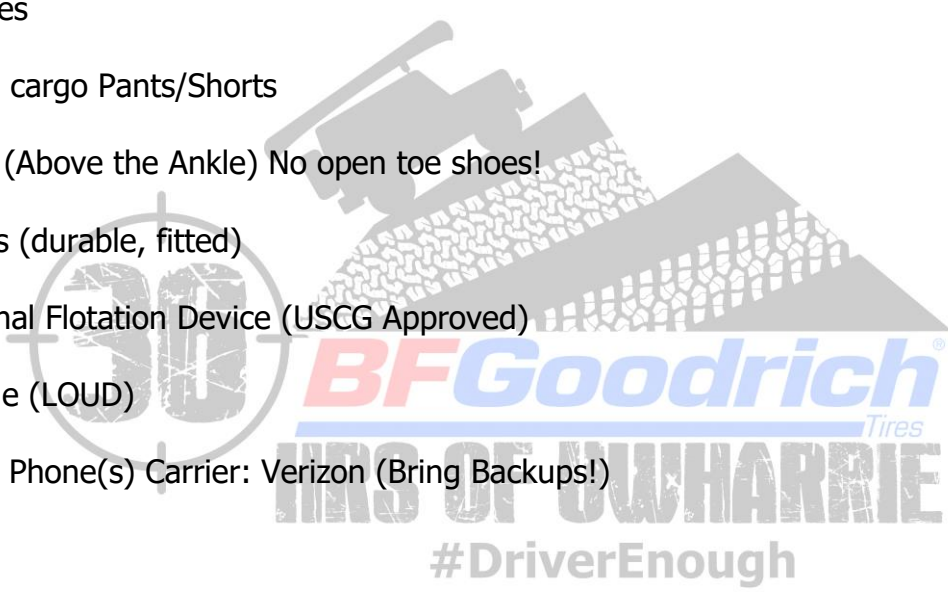

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Recovery Kit Checklist*

- Recovery Shackles (Breaking strength at least 4 times GVW)
- Winch (receiver mount is acceptable) (Minimum 1.5 x GVW)
- Hi-Lift (60" is recommended) (Must be a Hi-Lift brand)
- Kinetic Rope (20' Minimum)
- Recovery Strap (No Hooks)
- Tree Trunk Protector (3" minimum width)
- Winch Line Extension (50' minimum length)
- Pulley Block

*All recovery equipment must be rated to a minimum 4x Safety Factor to the weight of your vehicle and will be inspected at check-in. Example: 5,000 lb. (loaded vehicle) x 4 = 20,000 lbs. minimum or maximum breaking strength.
